Academic Completion Processing

- 1. Graduate School reviews and approves academic completion requests by the 8th of the month.
- 2. Academic Affairs and Registration Office verifies student information by the 10th of the month.
- 3. The Academic Affairs and Registration Office processes academic completion by the 20th of the month.

Academic Completion Approval

Step

1. University Academic Committee meeting every Tuesday in the 3rd and 4th weeks of the month. approximately 15 days

- 2. University Academic Council meeting every Tuesday in the 1st week of the month.
- 3. Check the list of graduates at https://mis.bsru.ac.th within 2 days after the meetings.
- 4. Submit a request for important educational documents to the **Academic Affairs and Registration Office.**
- 5. Receive important educational documents within 2 weeks after submitting the request.

Degree Certificate Approval

- 1. University Council meetings every 3rd Thursday of the month.
- 2. Attend BSRU's Commencement Ceremony to receive the degree certificate according to the university's announcement.

Throughout each step, students must fulfill all graduation criteria without any conditions
